This proposal summarises my dog Gaston who I offering for sale.

I've raised Gaston from eight weeks old and carefully selected him based on his genetics and the calibre of his breeder. He has proven time and again to have strong nerves, to be open and social, aggressive when appropriate, and he is proving to be a thorough and stubborn dog when on a track. These qualities are a combination of both his bloodlines and the time I have invested in his development.

I have sold dogs to the Australian Army, Western Australia Police, and to a Wildlife Conservation group that operates in East Gippsland. I understand what is needed by handlers and I'm confident that Gaston will impress, particularly when tracking in suburban terrain.

My dogs are a part of my family from day one until sold, and I care deeply for them. They do quite literally go everywhere with me; hence they've spent time in office spaces and in the bush with firearms. They start life in a crate in the bedroom I share with my wife, and we work together to ensure they're going to integrate well into a handler's home in the future.

CURRENT LEVEL OF TRAINING

For all skills described below, please refer to the video links to see Gaston perform what is described.

TRACKING / TRAILING / MANHUNTING

Gaston has been raised from eight weeks of age in both the Dick Staal and Jeff Schettler tracking systems.

The Dick Staal system was discontinued in June 2022 as it wasn't yielding results that I considered operationally relevant. He was achieving urban tracks up to 500m in busy urban environments when I ceased training in it.

The Jeff Schettler scent discrimination system has yielded incredible and consistent results. Gaston is trained to a very high standard in this skillset. I will send through his track overlays from August 2022 onwards to show his abilities, and many of his tracks are on his YouTube playlist for viewing with audio commentary. He is capable of tracking through suburban environments out 1km aged over forty minutes reliably.

ENGAGEMENT / OBEDIENCE

Very engaged and understands to activate the handler to begin a session. I have placed several videos on his YouTube playlist to demonstrate how we train and what he responds to and offers. His obedience requires continued proofing, although the foundation is very strong and well ingrained. His down-stay is progressing well and only requires additional work to add endurance and layers of distraction to it.

TEMPERAMENT

Gaston loves being slapped around and pinched and so on in play. He likes things rough. He is still quite mouthy and has no manners and will jump on people and generally be a bit of a menace in this regard. He is super social though, and has spent time in office spaces with me and loves a pat from people.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONFIDENCE

Gaston is very confident in every environment he has been exposed to, which is many. He has been exposed to a massive variety of locations to ensure he will be capable of operating anywhere required in future. Locations include but not limited to busy urban centres, farmland, military bases, firing ranges, simulated firing ranges, abandoned buildings, and busy office spaces.

GRIP WORK

He has done grip work on both an elevated bite table and on ground level utilising a flexi-pole. He has also been introduced to drive channelling going from prey drive to defence drive, and back. His grips are progressing well. He tends to be a bit chewy, but this is fading with maturity and work.

EQUIPMENT

- Flat collar: All training has been done on a flat collar.
- Prong collar: He has done a little bit of work on a prong collar, more so as in introduction and to clean up his heeling.
- Harness: The wearing of a harness is currently a strong cue for tracking about to commence.
- Muzzle: Gaston wears a muzzle very well, and will perform obedience and walk off lash in busy urban environments whilst wearing it.
- Choke chain collar: I have never used a metallic chain choker, but have used a thin choker collar when doing grip development only.

GENETIC MATERIAL RIGHTS

I propose to retain the rights to obtain semen (at my cost) in the future when he is of an optimum age for collection. This is something I do with all my sold dogs as I look to ensure that quality genetic material is kept accessible to breeders in this country.



SUMMARY

Gaston is a highly social and high drive dog. He lacks manners, but is an open and energetic dog. He is incredibly aggressive when the moment requires and has excellent instincts for reacting to suspicious behaviour, which he has done in the real world to great effect, scaring off potential thieves and seeking to engage them in the dark of night without prompting. He loves to be slapped and pinched and thrown around, and thinks rough play is the best kind of play. When tracking he is one of the most enjoyable dogs I have handled and his proximity alert is easy to read. He is easy to get along with. He is a very good dog and I look forward to him having a very successful working life.
